Subject: Extension of additional medical benefits to the existing and new members of “CPT Retired Employees (Contributory Outdoor and Indoor Medical Benefits) Scheme, 1997”- reg.

This has reference to this office earlier circulars of even No. dated 15.12.2021 & 30.11.2022 and Office Order No. Med/016/Cashless treatment/885 dated 10.01.2023 issued by the Medical Superintendent, HDC, in connection with the above subject.

2. In terms of approval of the Board for the Major Port Authority of SMP, Kolkata, vide Resolution No. R/314/HDC/MEDICAL/3/11/2022 dated 02.12.2022, all existing members of “CPT Retired Employees (Contributory Outdoor and Indoor Benefits) Scheme, 1997”, may avail of the following additional medical benefits, in addition to the existing medical benefits, subject to topping up their contribution as enumerated in para 3 below :-

- i) **Coronary Angiogram / Coronary Angioplasty** – twice in entire life span with maximum two stents;
- ii) **Cardiac valve replacement / repair** – two valves once in entire life span or one valve each in two separate sittings in the entire life span;
- iii) **G.I. Procedures** – Upper G.I. Endoscopy and Colonoscopy for diagnosis and treatment of the following conditions, e.g. inflammation, bleeding, polyp, tumor etc.

3. Since the aforesaid treatment procedures are not being undertaken at Centenary Hospital/ Port Hospital, Haldia and the patients would have to be referred to outside designated tie-up hospitals/investigation centers, reimbursement of the aforesaid procedures may be allowed as per prevalent CGHS rates. The existing members of the aforesaid Scheme will be required to top up their contribution to match the following level of amounts, as applicable, latest by 31.10.2023, to receive the aforesaid enhanced and additional medical facilities:-

Class of Employee at the time of superannuation/VR	Final amount after topping up
Class-I employee	Rs.50,000.00
Class-II employee	Rs.40,000.00
Class-III employee	Rs.30,000.00
Class-IV employee	Rs.20,000.00


N.B.: Half of the aforesaid amount will be required to be paid, if only the retired employee or only the family pensioner, who is existing member of the aforesaid Scheme, opts for the scheme.

Existing members of the aforesaid scheme may, however, choose to continue with the existing medical benefits without the aforesaid additional medical facilities, during their entire life time, without topping up their contribution.

4. New members of "CPT Retired Employees (Contributory Outdoor and Indoor Benefits) Scheme, 1997", will have to deposit the entire amount, as applicable and detailed in **para 3** above, as one time contribution, in order to avail of treatment (existing medical facilities and the aforesaid enhanced, additional medical facilities) after retirement. In other words, new members will not have option to pay less than the respective amount mentioned in para 3 above and avail of truncated medical facilities after retirement.

5. As Board has approved the proposal on 02.12.2022, employees retired prior to 02.12.2002, who got themselves enrolled in the Scheme prior to 02.12.2022 on payment of the pre-revised contribution, would be considered as existing members. Employees, who would get themselves enrolled in the aforesaid Scheme on or after 02.12.2022 irrespective of their actual date of retirement, would be required to pay the enhanced contribution in entirety and they will be considered as new member. However, any employee, who retired on or after 02.12.2022, may enrol himself in the scheme only as new member, irrespective of the date of deduction of contribution by Finance Department.

6. This supersedes Office Order No. Med/016/Cashless treatment/885 dated 10.01.2023 issued by the Medical Superintendent, HDC.
