WHEREAS you are in occupation of the public premises described in the Schedule below. (Please see on reverse).

AND WHEREAS, by written notice dated 01.06.2018 you were called upon to show cause on/or before 22.06.2018 why an order requiring you to pay a sum of Rs. 7,68,387.12/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Sixty Eight Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Seven and Twelve Paise only.) being the rent payable together with compound interest in respect of the said premises should not be made;

And whereas you have failed to represent the instant proceedings inspite of repeated chances being given to you. Even Paper Publication of the Notice yield no fruitful result and therefore no evidence have been produced by you in support of your case.



FINAL ORDER

The instant proceedings arises out of the application dated 05.01.2016 filed by Kolkata Port Trust (KoPT), Applicant herein, praying for recovery of rental dues, interest etc against Sri Bakshiram Jaiprakash, O.P. herein, under relevant provision of the Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorised Occupants) Act 1971. The facts of the case is summarised here under.

It is the case of KoPT that land measuring about 677.262 som at Ramkristopur, Thana and Registration Dist.- Howrah under Plate No. HL-64/A was allotted to the O.P. by the Port Authority on month to month lease basis. It has been claimed that O.P. failed to pay monthly rent and taxes as also interest as applicable as per KoPT rules. As per KoPT, O.P. was required to vacate the premises in terms of the Notice to Quit dated 16.05.2011 served as per statute. It is the specific submission that O.P. has no authority under law to occupy the public premises on the expiry of period as mentioned in the notice to quit dated 16.05.2011 as served upon O.P. by the Port Authority. In view of the Quit Notice representative of KoPT took over possession of the subject premises on 22.12.2011.

The instant Proceeding No. 1610/R of 2017 is for adjudication of application being No. Lnd.3222/II/16/3023 dated 05.01.2016 submitted by Kolkata Port Trust (KoPT), the Applicant herein, praying for order for recovery of arrear rent, taxes, along with interest from Sri Bakshiram Jaiprakash, O.P. herein.

This Forum of Law issued show cause notice under Section 7 of the PP Act to O.P. dated 01.06.2018 for the purpose initiation of adjudication process as envisaged under the Act. It reveals from record that the Notice under Section 7 has been return from the postal Department with the acknowledgement 'Unclaimed' which was send at the recorded address of O.P. As a result thereof, the Notice under Section 7 was published in Kolkata Port Trust's website and in English Daily "The Telegraph" on 25.07.2018 which

As no one appeared on behalf of O.P. or any person interested in this proceedings inspite of publication of notice in Daily Newspaper having wide circulation, I have no bar to allow the prayer of KoPT for recovery of rental dues from O.P. Department is directed to draw formal order for rent u/s.7 of the Act for Rs. 7,68,387.12/- for the period 01.08.1994 to 31.12.2011(both days inclusive), directing O.P. to pay the amount on or before 22.09.2019 and it is hereby ordered that O.P. shall make payment of the aforesaid sum to KoPT by 22.09.2019. In terms of Section 7 (2-A) of the PP Act, 1971, such dues attract simple interest @ 6.75 % per annum, which is the current rate of interest as per the Interest Act, 1978 (as gathered by me from the official website of the State Bank of India) from the date of incurrence of liability, till the liquidation of the same, as per the adjustment of payments, if any made so far by O.P., in terms of KoPT's books of accounts. I sign the formal order u/s 7 (1) & (2-A) of the Act.I make it clear that in the event of failure on the part of O.P. to pay the amount to KoPT as aforesaid, Port Authority is entitled to proceed further for recovery of its claim in accordance with law.

All concerned are directed to act accordingly.
