Whereas I, the undersigned, am of opinion on the grounds specified below that you are in unauthorised occupation of the public premises mentioned in the schedule below and that you should be evicted from said premises

GROUNDS

THAT YOU HAVE VIOLATED THE FUNDAMENTAL CONDITION FOR GRANT OF MONTHLY LEASE IN RESPECT OF PUBLIC PREMISES BY KOLKATA PORT TRUST (KOPT). THAT YOU HAVE DEFAULTED IN MAKING PAYMENT OF RENT AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE OF NOTICE TO QUIT. THAT YOU HAVE MADE UNAUTHORIZED ENCROACHMENT UPON THE PUBLIC PREMISES IN QUESTION. It transpires from the application dated 05.04.2019 of KoPT that O.P. came into occupation of the Port Property being land measuring about74.880sqm.situated at Chetla Railway Siding in the presidency town of Kolkata (under Plate No- D453/1/A) in question as a lessee on month to month term and is in default of making payment of the monthly rent and taxes. It is submitted that O.P. has no authority under law to occupy the public premises after issuance of notice to quit dated 21.05.1982 and was required to hand over the possession of the property in question to KoPT on 01.07.1982 as required under the notice to quit. My attention is drawn that the cause of action arises upon failure on the part of the O.P. to hand over possession in terms of the said notice dated 21.05.1982 as duly served upon O.P. is well within the jurisdiction of the Office of the Estate Officer.

It is argued that O.P. is in wrongful occupation on and from 01.07.1982 and is liable to pay compensation charges/mesne profits for unauthorized use and occupation of the Port property in question.

My attention is drawn to the Schedule X and Z of KoPT's application dated 05.04.2019 in this regard.

Heard the submissions and considered the matter on the basis of materials on record. After careful consideration of the submissions made on behalf of KoPT and materials produced before me, I find that KoPT has made out a case to proceed against O.P. under relevant provisions of The Public Premises (Eviction Of Unauthorised Occupants) Act, 1971 (which shall hereinafter be referred to as "The Act") and Rules made thereunder.

Let notice under Section 4 of the Act be issued to O.P. for production of documents, evidence and hearing etc. on 22.16.19 at <u>5.2m</u>.

Now we must give a meaning to the term "Unauthorized Occupation" as per definition provided in the P.P. Act itself. At this stage, for the purpose of adjudication of KoPT's claim for damages only under Schedule C of KoPT's application dated 05.04.2019 which may have arisen due to unauthorized use and occupation of the public premises in question, after serving ejectment notice, I find no bar to assess the damages as per Rules made under the Act.

In my consideration KoPT has made out an arguable claim for such assessment of damages. As such issue of notice accordingly to O.P. in terms of section 7 of
