I. NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS / DEVELOPMENTS

Biggest Tanker till date Visits SMP, Kolkata

On 14.9.23 'M.T. CLEAROCEAN AJAX', the biggest vessel of its kind with the highest ever parcel load of 48,111 MT carrying Naphtha, (a/c HPL) was anchored at HOJ-III of HDC for the first time making SMP Kolkata privileged enough to handle such a big tanker.



New Multimodal Transport Route for Container Movement between India and Bangladesh

SMP, Kolkata and Saif Powertec Ltd, Bangladesh (SPL) joined hands for time and cost-efficient, collaborative solution by signing a MoU on 25.9.23 to establish a new multimodal transport route for Container movement between India and Bangladesh.

The containerized liner service sector will foster trade and shipment between Bangladesh and India through Mongla and Chattogram Sea Ports, as well as Pangoan River Port of Bangladesh.


Capacity Building Program organized by SMPK

II CARGO THROUGHPUT :

- SMP, Kolkata handled 31.159 million metric tonnes (MMT) of cargo during April -September, 2023 vis-à-vis 30.909 MMT during April -September, 2022, registering an increase of 0.81%.
- SMP, Kolkata has achieved a significant milestone by handling 3,78,982 Containers (TEUs) during April-September, 2023 compared to 3,44,953 Containers (TEUs) during the same period in 2022, registering a remarkable growth of 9.86% and improved its position from the 5th rank in 2022-23 to the 3rd rank among Indian Major Ports in terms of handling of Containers during April-September, 2023.
- HDC handled 22.88 MMT of cargo during April -September, 2023 vis-à-vis 22.845 MMT during April -September, 2022 (**an increase of 0.15%**). KDS handled 8.279 MMT of cargo in April -September, 2023 vis-à-vis 8.064 mt during April -September, 2022 (**an increase of 2.67%**).
- HDC registered growth in respect of POL (Product), Other Liquid, Vegetable Oil, Iron Ore, Other Coal / Coke (Incl. Metallurgical Coke), Fly Ash, Container TEUs etc. while KDS registered growth in respect of Vegetable Oil, Finished Fertilizer, Other Coal / Coke, Pulses & Peas, Fly Ash, Container (both in terms of TEUs and Tonnage) etc. during April -September, 2023 vis-à-vis corresponding period of last year.

III CONTAINER TRAFFIC:

SMP, Kolkata handled 3,78,982 TEUs (KDS: 3,22,373 & HDC: 56,609) during April -September, 2023 vis-à-vis 3,44,953 TEUs (KDS: 2,91,028 & HDC: 53,925) during April -September, 2022, an increase of 9.86%.

IV SHIP TRAFFIC:

During April -September, 2023, 1613 ships (KDS: 622, HDC: 991) called at SMP, Kolkata vis-a-vis 1491 ships (KDS: 534, HDC: 957) in April -September, 2022, an increase of 8.18 %. 1989 vessels (991 inward; 998 outward) passed through Eden Channel during April -September, 2023 to / from Haldia vis-à-vis 1914 vessels (957 inward; 957 outward) during April -September, 2022.

V COMPARATIVE PERFORMANCE :

SMP, Kolkata ranked 1st in handling of Coking/Other Coal, 2nd in handling of Other Liquids and 3rd in handling of Container TEUs & Other Misc. Cargo amongst Indian Major Ports during April to September 2023.

V RAILWAY TRAFFIC :

During April -September, 2023, SMP, Kolkata handled rail borne cargo of 16.84 MMT (HDC-14.17, KDS-2.67 MMT) against 17.56 MMT (HDC-14.44 MMT, KDS – 3.12 MMT) in April -September, 2022, registering a drop of 4.1%. During April - September, 2023, 637 rakes were received and 640 despatched at KDS; at HDC, 3200 rakes were received and 3193 were despatched in the period under review.
